NOTICE OF RACE

VENUE

The Wakayama International Regatta 2011 for the Olympic classes and Youth classes will be held 7-11 OCT 2011 and sailed on the Wakaura-bay off Wakayama, Japan.

ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority is the Japan Sailing Federation, the Wakayama Sailing Federation, and the Wakayama Sailing Club.

CLASSES

Olympic classes: 470 M&F, RS:X M&F, Laser M and Radial F

Youth classes: 420 , Radial and RS:X

RULES

The Wakayama International Regatta 2011 will be governed by rules that are defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. Appendix P will apply.

DISPLAY *Advertisement / On Board Cameras*

Boats will be required to display advertisement of the event sponsors as indicated by the organisation. Competitors may be required to carry on-board cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment on their boats.

ELIGIBILITY

ISAF Eligibility according to Appendix 2, and a membership for each class association is required for competitors.

All youth class competitors shall be under the age of 19 years on 31 December 2011 (born after 31 December 1992).

ENTRIES

Entries shall be made on the official entry form on the Wakayama Sailing Club website (<http://www.wakayama-sailing.org/>). Fully completed entry forms should be received at the entry address no later than 31 Aug 2011.

ENTRY CONFIRMATION

All entries, when accepted, will be displayed on the Wakayama Sailing Club website. This display can be considered as a confirmation.

REGISTRATION

Competitors shall register at the Registration Office at the Wakayama Sailing Centre, prior to competing in the Wakayama International Regatta. The Registration Office will be open on Wednesday, 7 Sep 2011, 09.00 - 18.00 hrs, And Thursday, 8 Sep 2011, 08.00 - 10.00 hrs.

For the Youth classes, the registration Office will be Open on Saturday, 10 Sep 2011, 08.00 – 10.00 hrs.

FEES

The following entry fees (in Japanese Yen) include welcome party fee (¥3000 per person), will be charged:

Any entry received after, 1 Sep 2011, will be charged a double entry fee.

Payment of Fees

The above mentioned fees (when applicable) are to be paid only in Japanese Yen, and in cash at registration, prior to competing in the Wakayama international Regatta.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The Race Format will be as decided by JSAF Olympic committee and similar to the ISAF worlds.

The regatta will consist of an opening series and a medal race. The top ten finishers in the opening series of each event will advance to the medal race.

SCHEDULE OF RACES

The starting time of the first race will not be before 13:00 hrs on Thursday, 8 Sep 2011 (Youth classes will not be before 13.00 hrs on Saturday, 10 Sep 2011).

The starting time of the first race after the 2nd racing day will not be before the 10:00 hrs.

No warning signal will be made after 11:00 hrs on Sunday, 11 Sep 2011 for fleet racing. (16.30 hrs for medal races)

SAIL NUMBERS

According to RRS G1.1 (b) the National Letters denoting her National Authority shall also be carried on her sail by boats of the Laser and Radial Classes.

COURSE AREAS

There will be two or three course areas.

The length of the course(s) will be set to meet the target time for each race as set for the Olympic Games (if any).

SCORING SYSTEM

The low point Scoring System, Rule A4, will apply to all Racing.

INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with rule 91.

SHORE FACILITIES

Boats will be accommodated at Wakayama Sailing centre.

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

Competitors will participate in the Wakayama International regatta entirely at their own risk. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for personal or material damage, injury or death, sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the Wakayama international Regatta. The Organising Authority disclaims any and all such liability.
