- \bigtriangledown To readily identify themselves as media personnel, all press and/or media members are requested to wear the official bibs and ID badges provided by the sponsors.
- \bigtriangledown Media coverage of athletes is prohibited before the regatta commences, and this includes while they are standing by to check on wind conditions.
- ∇ Do not enter the boat park located at the harbor without permission.
- ▽ Coverage of the regattas at sea is enabled by applying for permission to board one of the press boats arranged by the sponsors. All media personnel must comply with the guidance and instructions of the staff when onboard the press boats.
 Note: Each press boat has a maximum passenger capacity; therefore, there may be situations when media personnel will not be able to board the craft.
- \bigtriangledown News coverage from aboard private boats is not allowed as is coverage while riding along in a coach boat of a team.
- \bigtriangledown Sponsors will establish mixed zones for the media at each regatta and event. The locations of the mixed zones will be posted at each regatta and event.


 \bigtriangledown At the same time the athletes representing Japan in the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games are announced, a concurrent interview with them is scheduled after the announcement ceremony.
